Next month, when they arrive at the Port of Lagos, the Nigerian ministry will have enough materials for more than a thousand couples — literally — to be involved in lifechanging HomeBuilders Bible studies and attend Art of Marriage events!

When you think of "ministry," making shipping arrangements may not be the first thing that comes to mind. But it is ministry because it facilitates the ministry of many others and impacts countless lives and marriages!
