We will be collecting the items below to be placed in gallon-sized ziplock bags. Each bag will contain a variety of these items, as well as a tract explaining the Gospel, information about St. Andrew's and GiG and a phone list of agencies that provide services for the homeless. As funds allow, additional items may be included that would be of use on the streets.

As these items are donated, Blessing Bags will be packed and placed on the Missions Desk in the Narthex. Feel free to grab a few and keep them in your car to hand to those in need during the winter and spring.

All items must be NEW

Small, easy-open fruits/applesauce	Travel-size deoderant
Small fruit juice boxes/pouches <i>(not KoolAid)</i>	Travel-size hand lotions
Small Vienna Sausages	Bus tokens <i>(Little Rock Transit)</i>
